

# **Notes on In/Out and Health Control of PGH and S1 Residents during Epidemic Prevention Period V11**

10/08/2020

1. Returning residents have to conduct 14 days self-health management. Residents should measure body temperature three times a day and report to the management company. Abnormality detected should be reported immediately. PGH will random check the body temperature record and severe penalty will be imposed for any violation.
2. Residents need to perform the second nucleic acid testing within 7 to 14 days after the first nucleic acid testing. If the result is negative, self-health management can be released.
3. Residents (except management staff) must present Macao Health and measure body temperature for every entry to / exit from PGH and S1. According to the government guideline, residents are not allowed to enter or need to undergo quarantine if the health code is red; if the health code is yellow residents must observe strict self-health management, apart from three times of body temperature checking and disposal of rubbish, residents are not allowed to use public facilities such as pantries, laundries, study rooms or sports facilities before the health code turns into green. Yellow health code holders can present negative result of nucleic test to replace self-health management.
4. All must wear masks in dormitory public area. The management staff has the right to ask for cooperation.
5. If any residents need to pick up personal items, they should apply through [sao.pgh@um.edu.mo](mailto:sao.pgh@um.edu.mo) in advance. They need to report to the management company after getting approval, and have body temperature measured and conduct sanitization. The management company staff will then accompany the student and get the stuff within appointed time, then leave campus immediately.
6. All residents must observe University, PGH and S1 epidemic controlling measures. While feeling unwell, please report to the management company immediately by calling 88222531 / 88222518.
7. All residents must follow this guideline, and eviction order will be issued to any serious offender.
