- \rightarrow No award will be given if there are less than <u>5</u> applicants for such award.

III. Prizes

Prize for each award includes a certificate and MOP 1,000 cash coupons.

IV. Eligibility and rules

- Activities organized by student organizations of UMSU or UMPA from 1 April 2024 to 31 Mar 2025 are eligible for application.
- Final result of Award #1 and Award #2 will be generated from the Judging Panel.
- Applicant who has the highest score will be the winner of that award.
- The highest score is 10. No awardee of the abovementioned awards will be generated if its score is below 6.
- Results of Award #3 & Award #4 will be generated by the Online Voting.
- Members of judging panel include
 - 1 representative from SAO,
 - 1 representative from OSA,
 - 1 representative from RC,
 - 1 representative from UMSU,
 - 1 representative from UMPA.
- Member of student association applying for any of the student awards cannot be the member of judging panel at the same time.

2024-2025 Student Organization Awards Evaluation Guidelines

Awards & Objectives

- 1) **Best Student Organization Award:** This award is presented to student organizations that made meaningful and significant contributions and conveyed positive messages to students, the university or the society as a whole throughout the year.
- Best Student Activity Award: This award is presented to student activities that demonstrates the UM image and culture, collaboration, creativity and contribution to students and/or society.
- 3) Most Favorite Student Organization Award: This award is presented to student organization that is most popular among our students throughout the year. The one which help to promote positive atmosphere in campus and has good image within our students. This award will be evaluated via Online Voting in campus.
- 4) Most Favorite Student Activity Award: This award is presented to student activity that is most popular among our students throughout the year. Also, it helps to promote positive atmosphere to our campus. This award will be evaluated via Online Voting in campus.

Evaluation Criteria (for Judging Panel)

The evaluation criteria of the awards is based as following, scores will be given in the scale of 1-10:

Effective execution and planning of events
Fulfillment of responsibilities both in and outside
Participation in UM activities
Continuous improvement & able to achieve smooth succession
